A 2014 Graduate of Jackson High School. She was a 4-year letter winner and 2-time JHS bowler of the year. She was a 3-year 1st team all-conference award winner and 2-time Stark County bowler of the year.

She is a Sectional individual champion and

4-time State Qualifier; reaching all 4 years with the team. She was voted Canton Repository Bowler of the Week during here illustrious career. She had a 298 game and three 500+ 2-game series in her high school career. After high school she went on to attend school and bowl for Notre Dame College of Ohio. The team was 3-time nationals' qualifiers. She finished with the 22nd best average in the nation her senior year of college. She has 2 300's since high school and multiple 700 series. She recorded a career high average of 223 during the 2021-22 season, which earned her the Eagles 190 league bowler of the year. Her Travel League team, which included fellow HOF member (Kara), was recently awarded with 2-women, 1-man team high series in the nation for the 2021-2022 season. She has been working in marketing for an animal health corporation for 5 years, has been the Boys Varsity bowling coach for Canton Central Catholic for 3 years, head of the Stark County Bowling Youth Committee for 3 years and married less than a year ago. Taylor is passionate about the sport and plans to stay heavily involved in the bowling community for years to come!

Hall of Fame Information

Nomination Process:

A candidate may be nominated for Hall of Fame membership by any member of the community. Formal nomination shall be made using the nomination form prescribed for such purpose and made available to the public. The nomination form must be received by the SCHSBC by **January 1st** of voting year. Application packets will be on the SCHSBC website schsb.org

Eligibility for Nomination:

Athletes are eligible for nomination 10 years after their class's graduation. They must be in good standing or in special circumstances as determined by the Board Members. Such athletes must have competed in 3 years of SCHSBC competitions and must have been on 1st Team all conference at least one year. Among the accomplishments taken into account will be individual (all-conference, all-district, all-state) and team accomplishments, (districts, regional and state qualifiers). Individual school or team records held, and impact on teams and overall SCHSBC during their era and accomplishments, thereafter.

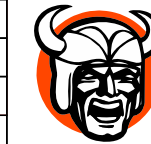

Since high school, Kara can still be found on the lanes, having had 1 300 game in the city tournament along with numerous 700 series. Her best series to date is a impressive 794.

She has been to the USBC Open Championship to date, 6 times. She is averaging 171 for her career at the Open. Her team placed 22nd in 2021 and 55th in 2022. Kara and fellow HOF inductee were a part of the Nation's highest score for 2 woman, 1 man team with their high series in 2021-2022 season. Kara has worked in medical billing for the past 3.5 years and am currently attending college for medical coding. Kara married fellow SCHSBC alum Adam Kutz in August of 2022. Where she continues to this day loving to spend time with her family and bowling with her husband.

Matthew Moecia

Is a 2003 graduate from Massillon Washington High School. High school bowling was officially formed during his junior year in 2001-2002, for Stark County. Matts memories of his time include, going door to door with his coach and mentor Dick Moecia, coach (and fellow HOF Member) Russ Warrington, his father Richard Moecia and all the surrounding coaches hoping and wanting this to snowball together to form this conference of high school bowling. Matt was a two-time state qualifier, being apart of the first Massillon team to travel to the state championships, finishing 5th his senior season. He was able to anchor the team that won the Stark County high school bowling conference championship in 2003. He also received high school bowler of the year and anchor award in 2003. His best set in high school was in match play at AMF hall of fame lanes where he had 17 consecutive strikes in a row for games of 279 and 278. Matt is now a father of two wonderful children Dominic and Natalie Moecia and owns a landscape business called Mow King Property Solutions.
